Hello! We hope you are all doing well, and staying cool during this HOT summer. We are very near to our target date for returning to Ghana and have so much to share with you!

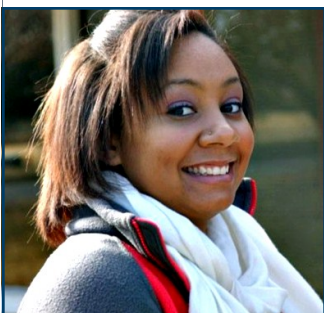
10 Weeks 'till Ghana!

Our family's target return to Ghana date is **September 20th!** The Lord has brought us so far, yet we still have so far to go! We are moving forward in faith, and trusting Him as He directs our steps. (Proverbs 20:24)

Our biggest obstacle at this point is financial support for monthly expenses. It costs \$24,000 annually, or \$2,000 monthly, for us to live and minister in Ghana. *The Lord has provided the means needed for us to **get** to Ghana. Now we are trusting Him for the means to **stay** in Ghana.*

There is so much to do when you are relocating a family of four to a developing nation. The next ten weeks will be packed full with our mile long "to do" list of renewing passports, applying for visas, getting vaccinations (none for the kids this time around, thank goodness!), etc... And then there is the packing! Things such as clothes and household items that can't be easily found in Ghana must be purchased in advance. We must carefully and thoughtfully weigh (literally) everything and decided what to bring and what to leave behind. We are only allowed so much weight in luggage and every ounce counts!
