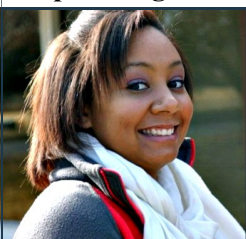

Family News

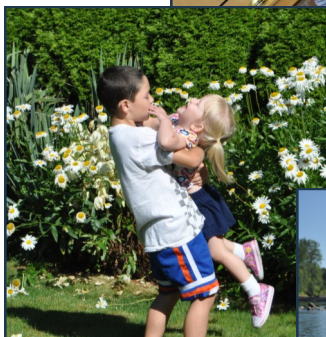
